Step by Step Manual - Prevetti Automatic Watches with Date/Day



Crown - 1 Click, 2 Clicks

On watches with a day and date or date only, the crown can be pulled out in 2 clicks.

First Click

Used to set the day and date.

- Rotate one way to set the day, and the other way to set the date.
- Day and date should not be set between 9:30 PM and 3:30 AM as the date may change incorrectly.

Second Click

Used to set the time.

- Remember to account for 12 noon and 12 midnight.

Setting

- Pull the crown to the first click when the second hand is at 12 o'clock.
- Set the day to the day before by rotating the crown.
- Set the date to the day before by rotating the crown.
- Pull the crown to the second click.
- Advance the time until the day and/or date changes to the correct day and/or date.

- It is now midnight. Set the time to the correct time. If it is past noon, the hands should pass 12 o'clock once before setting correctly.

- Push the crown all the way in.

NH35A Automatic Movement

This Prevetti wristwatch is powered by a Seiko NH35A automatic movement, which charges while in motion. It features 24 jewels, 21,600 vibrations per hour, and a 41-hour power reserve when fully charged. The movement can also be manually wound (requires about 55 turns of the crown for full charge), and the second hand can be stopped for precise time setting. The movement is protected by Seiko's patented Diashock technology, with an accuracy tolerance of -20/+40 seconds per day at full charge.
